

Enrolment

In order to become a student, you will have to go through the registration process, at the beginning of the academic year.

Look for information on the website of the faculty to which you have been admitted or on the university website www.ugal.ro.





The University will issue two important documents for you: the **student card** and the **student transportation card**.

These documents are needed to prove your **student status**.

Who do you turn to when you have a problem?

Go to your **class leader** and, if you can't find a solution to your problem, to your **year leader**.

Get in touch with your **year tutor** (each year of study has an assigned tutor). The tutor is a faculty member assigned to support your guidance and integration into the university environment.

If, however, you are unable to find a solution to your problem, contact the **pro-dean in charge of student activities** at your faculty and then the **dean** of your faculty.

You can also contact **student representatives in the University Senate or student associations**.

University education is divided into three study cycles:

- Postgraduate studies (1 2 years);
- PhD. studies (3 4 years).




How do we read the timetable?


Subjects marked **above** that line take place in **odd weeks** (starting with the first week of the semester), and those marked **below** the line take place in **even weeks**.

Access to IT resources

"Dunărea de Jos" University of Galati offers its students numerous facilities through free IT resources (*Guide to the use of IT resources offered* to students by "Dunărea de Jos" University of Galati)

You received your access credentials to the web resources when you signed your study contract or through a request to the faculty secretariat.

To find out a grade (once you have obtained your access credentials) you need to access the **School Reports** section of the website <u>www.student.ugal.ro</u>.

Credentials can be used to access the following resources:

- **Calendar** the calendar is synchronised with mobile devices and allows easy management of all school activities;
- Connecting to the Wi-Fi network EduRoam;
- Storage students have access to 1TB of cloud-accessible space;
- **School reports** school reports can be consulted online by all University students;
- access Microsoft Teams and Microsoft 365.

Tuition fees

Within the University, there are both students admitted to budgeted seats and students admitted to fee-paying seats. This fee differs according to the faculty.

The tuition fees can be paid at the University **cashier's office** (*U body, University headquarters in Domnească Street no. 47, room U13, ground floor*), by money order, postal order or bank transfer).

The explanation of the payment will be:

- **Type of tuition fee** (exemple: admission fee, tuition fee, reregistration fee, fee for previous years' arrears with the name of the subject, laboratory work/seminars with the name of the subject, e.g. completion of bachelor's/master's studies, etc.).

Residence permit

After entering Romania you must obtain a residence permit. This certifies your right to stay in Romania and can be obtained from the territorial units of the General Inspectorate for Immigration in the city where you live.



To obtain a residence permit, you will have to submit a series of documents in person at least 30 days before the expiry of the right of residence granted by the visa. You can also submit the documents via the online application, available at

https://portaligi.mai.gov.ro/portaligi/.

In order to obtain the residence permit in Romania, the steps described bellow need to be followed:

- 1.You will ask the Secretariat of the Faculty where you study to issue a certificate for the residence permit for you;
- 2.You should go to the headquarter of the University, room U90 in order to receive the second certificate for the residence permit;
- 3. You should make sure that you add to your file the following documents:
- <u>request</u>;

- **original and copy of the border crossing document** (passport, travel document, etc.);

- **letter of acceptance to study** - only required for the first extension of the right of residence;

- **certificate issued by the educational institution** proving that they are enrolled in a state or private educational institution, accredited or provisionally authorised by law, in the form of daytime education, including participation in doctoral courses, on the basis of approval by the relevant ministry;

- **proof of means of subsistence**, amounting to at least the minimum gross basic salary per country guaranteed for a period of at least 6 months;

- proof of legal ownership of accommodation (original and copy);
- medical certificate;
- fees.

ERASMUS+

It is an European Union programme with a budget of €26.27 billion allocated for the period 2021-2027 to support education, training, youth and sport in Europe.



Student mobility for study or internship is possible only on the basis of interinstitutional agreements that the Erasmus Office of the "Dunărea de Jos" University of Galati has concluded with partner universities/institutions/companies etc. from **over 50 EU and non-EU countries.**

Through study and internship mobility abroad, master's and doctoral students can acquire new communicative, linguistic, intercultural and non-technical skills, which are net advantages for increasing employability.

DURATION

- min. 2 months
- max. 12 months (24 months for students specialising in Medicine)

ADVANTAGES

- full recognition of the mobility period and credits obtained;
- free tuition at the host university;
- Monthly grant: between €606 and €824, depending on the type of mobility and host country;
- maintaining the status of UDJG scholarship student;
- **additional financial support** (top-up of €250/month) for study and placement mobility for students from disadvantaged backgrounds;
- additional financial support for students with special needs (medical scholarship), depending on the recommendations in the medical report, etc.

Student camps

The Student Camp Programme is aimed at students enrolled in **full-time education** at one of the university's bachelor's and master's degree programmes, aged up to **35 years** old, students who have completed all subjects of study in the previous academic year. For students in the **social cases category** (students orphaned by both parents, those from children's homes or foster care, Roma, graduates of high schools in rural areas or towns with less than 10,000 inhabitants and those receiving social scholarships) and students working in **CCS or Student Federations** the criterion of passing the exams in all subjects does not apply.

The camps take place during the summer holidays, **in the mountains** or **by the sea**.



Students are entitled to free places in camps, within the limit of the places allocated, on the basis of an application submitted to the faculty, depending on the results obtained in their studies and the activity carried out in an organised framework at various cultural, artistic, scientific, sporting or voluntary events. Students also receive free accommodation and meals for the duration of the camps.



Transport

All students enrolled in full-time education (bachelor's, master's, doctorate) at state-accredited institutions, aged up to 30 years, receive a 90% discount on domestic rail transport, **according to the legislation in force**. Students who are orphans or come from children's homes will benefit from free tickets.

Romanian/foreign students benefit from a **50% discount** for local transport. Orphan students or students from children's homes benefit from free tickets. The 50% discount and free transport tickets for students are issued on the basis of the student ID card for the current academic year and an identity document.

Students receive a single monthly subscription with a 50% discount or free of charge, as appropriate. For more information about the local public transport tickets, please contact the secretariat of the faculty or the UDJG Economics Department.





In the dormitories, students benefit from reading rooms, fitness and aerobics rooms, laundry facilities equipped with washing and drying machines and internet (all these services are provided free of charge by the "Dunărea de Jos" University of Galati).

The student chapel "Sfintii Trei Ierarhi" is also located in the student dormitories.

The accommodation capacity in student dormitories is about **3000** places.

"Florin Balaiș" Sports Complex

The "Florin Balaiş" Sports Complex of "Dunărea de Jos" University of Galati, 44 Mihai Bravu Street, has a covered sports hall with an area of 800 square meters, with stands for audience.

The hall is equipped with changing rooms, shower rooms, sanitary facilities, storage rooms for sports equipment. Within the complex there is also a full-size clay tennis court for singles and doubles matches, a 380 m long clay track with two running lanes, a football pitch with synthetic grass and a night-time facility, as well as an outdoor concrete basketball and volleyball court with a total area of 250 sqm.

The "**Florin Balaiş**" Sports Complex is accessible to students and teachers from UDJG, its modern facilities allowing the optimal development of physical education activities, as well as various student sports competitions.



University Centre of Physio-Kinesiology and Medical Recovery

Students wishing to obtain certification for the teaching profession can enroll in the **PSYCHOPEDAGOGICAL TRAINING PROGRAMME - LEVEL I and LEVEL II**, carried out by the Department for Teacher Training (DPPD).

There are two levels of psycho-pedagogical training:

Level I (initial), which takes place during undergraduate studies, confers partial certification for the teaching profession, with the right to teach in secondary education and lower secondary education; it ends with a graduation certificate - 30/35 credits;

Level II (advanced), is taken during master's studies or postgraduate studies, after obtaining the bachelor's/master's degree and the Level I certificate; it provides the teaching skills needed to teach in secondary, university and postgraduate education; it ends with obtaining the graduation certificate - 30 credits.

The psychoeducational training program is optional, credits are separate from those earned in bachelor's/master's programs and do not affect scholarships or the student's budget/tuition place.

Department of Distance and Part time education

Distance Learning (ID) is a form of organising teaching activities that gives students/learners the opportunity to personally choose where and when to learn. Distance learning, also called distance education, elearning or online learning, is characterized by the physical separation of teachers and students in the learning process and the use of diversified technologies to facilitate student-teacher and student-student communication. A distance learning study programme may be offered entirely at a distance or it may be a combination of distance and face-to-face educational activities carried out in the higher education institution (Blended Learning). Distance learning courses may use a variety of methods, technologies and resources for instruction and communication, such as video/audio conferencing, internet-mediated web techniques, digital or printed study materials.

Part-time education (IFR) is a form of organisation of the teaching process characterised by teaching-learning-assessment activities dedicated to applied training, scheduled on a compact or regular basis, which involves both the direct encounter of students/learners with teaching staff in the university environment and the use of teaching/training resources specific to distance learning.

Galați - City by the Danube



The Danube esplanade of Galati is a representative area of the city of Galati and is arranged for walking, but also for sports and recreational activities. The esplanade is about 4 km long, parallel to the Danube (the longest esplanade in Europe along the Danube). On the Danube bank in Galati, there is also the **Television Tower**, a unique construction in Romania, 110 metres high.

The Public Garden is located near the "Alexandru Ioan Cuza" Student Complex and occupies a generous area of about 100.000 sqm. It is a perfect area for recreational activities, especially for students.

The "Răsvan Angheluță" Natural Science Museum Complex is one of the great natural science museums in Romania and includes Botanical Garden. the the Astronomical Observatory, the first observatory with a roof that can be towed in Romania. and the Gârboavele Zoological Garden where you can go horse riding. Also in the Gârboavele Forest you will find the EscapeLand Adventure Park.

The "Danube" beach in Galati has a capacity of about 3,500 people. The beach includes a sandy area (equipped with shading systems, deckchairs, hammocks) and a slide area. Every year the beach hosts the Danube Rock Sounds festival. Next to Danube Beach there is an Adventure Park with a pumptrack for roller sports, a cycling trail, a hedge maze, a motorbike trail, a slide. an amphitheatre and landscaped green areas.



University assistant = person with the rank of assistant, first university teaching degree.

First cycle of studies = Bachelor's degree.

Second cycle of studies = Master's degree.

Third cycle of studies = Doctoral studies.

Microsoft Teams code = code allowing association to a team created on the Microsoft Teams platform.

Colloquium = form of verification and evaluation of knowledge consisting of discussions, practical work or laboratory work.

Associate professor = university teaching grade, intermediate between lecturer and professor.

Board of Directors = The Board of Directors consists of the rector, vice-rectors, deans, administrative director general, a student representative and permanent guests.

The Board of Directors within the University is headed by the President.

Faculty Council = is the decision-making and deliberative body at faculty level. It is composed of a maximum of 75% of full teaching and research staff and a minimum of 25% of students, elected by universal, direct and secret vote of all full teaching and research staff in the faculty and by universal, direct and secret vote of the students of the faculty.



ECTS credits = numbers associated with each subject in the curriculum, reflecting the amount of work invested by the student in the mastery of a subject. Each examination passed is assigned a number of credits.

Course = teaching activities during which the professor teaches the theoretical aspects of the subject.

Dean = member of the academic teaching staff who runs a faculty.

Department = manages the study programme/programmes gestionează. The department is headed by the department director.

Directorate-General for Administration = coordinates, through staff trained in the social-economic, administrative and technical fields, the entire administrative, technical and financial-accounting activity of the university.

Directorate-General Secretariat = coordinates and monitors the work of the faculty secretariats, the University's Study Documents Department, the Registrar's Office and the University Archives.

Exam = a form of verification and evaluation of knowledge, following a subject covered. It can be of the type of a written or practical test, during the exams session. An exam is considered passed if the grade 5 is obtained.

Expulsion = Excluding a student from university for various reasons: cheating on exams, not paying tuition fees or not passing the academic year with minimum credits.

Faculty = is the basic functional unit of the university, which develops and manages study programmes and has financial autonomy up to department level. The faculty may include one or more departments.

Subject sheet = pentru fiecare materie există o fișă a disciplinei, care cuprinde informații despre: tematica parcursă la fiecare întâlnire, bibliografia obligatorie, numărul de credite aferent și modalitatea de evaluare.

Laboratory = compulsory attendance activity, specific to each faculty, which involves putting into practice the concepts learned in the course.

Lecturer = university teaching grade, between assistant and lecturer.

Grade growth = if you have passed an exam and are not satisfied with your grade, you have the right to apply for a free re-examination to increase your grade. Your mark is only changed if you get a higher mark than your original one. Grades obtained are taken into account when calculating averages for scholarships, accommodation, student camps and annual reclassification.

Semester/year average = weighted average between grades and credits obtained; calculated according to the following formula:

Psycho-pedagogical module = optional courses during the Bachelor's and Master's cycle that offer the possibility for those who take them to teach in pre-university education.

Mid-term/verification exam = exam taken during the semester; it represents a percentage of the final grade.

Curriculum = comprises all the subjects, successively distributed by years of study and with weightings expressed in ECTS credits. In the curriculum you will find compulsory subjects, optional subjects and elective subjects.

President of the University Senate = represents the University Senate in its relations with the Rector and third parties.

Vice-dean = a member of the university teaching staff acting as deputy to the dean.

Professor = a person with special training in a particular field of activity and who teaches an educational subject; the highest teaching position in university education.

Vice-rector = member of the university teaching staff, acting as deputy to the rector.

Rector = the head and chief authorising officer of the university.

Re-enrolment = resumption of studies by an expelled person.

Resitting an exam= it is any examination not passed at the end of the examination session.

Seminar = teaching activity during which the professor teaches the practical aspects of the subject.

University Senate = represents the university community and is the highest decision-making and deliberating body at the institution. The University Senate is composed of 75% teaching and research staff and 25% student representatives.

Exams session = exam period at the end of a semester/academic year.




Bologna system = a form of harmonisation of the European academic system that structures education on three levels of university studies: bachelor, master and doctorate.


Student who completed all credits successfully = the student who has managed to pass all the exams in an academic year without any failed exams.

Tutor = professor appointed to provide support on academic work.


Maps 1. Map of the University buildings
